The get member function waits (by calling `wait()`) until the shared state is ready, then retrieves the value stored in the shared state (if any). Right after calling this function, `valid()` is false. ...

The class template `std::future` provides a mechanism to access the result of asynchronous operations: An asynchronous operation (created via `std::async`, `std::packaged_task`, ...
