Mauritania has signed its first independent power producer contract, a \$300 million agreement with Iwa Green Energy to develop a 60-megawatt hybrid solar-wind power plant.

Mauritania has signed a a \$300 million PPA agreement with Ewa Green Energy to build a hybrid power plant consisting of 160MW solar, 60MW wind and 370MWh battery storage.

On 12 September 2025, Mauritania signed a \$300 million agreement with renewable energy developer Ewa Green Energy to construct a 220-megawatt (MW) hybrid power plant near Nouakchott.

Mauritania has entered into a 0 million Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with Ewa Green Energy to develop a cutting-edge hybrid power plant featuring 160MW of solar energy, 60MW ...

The project will finance Mauritania's first large-scale battery energy storage facility, enabling the country to harness its abundant solar and wind resources for more reliable electricity.
